### Fourth of July coloring contest to be held in Hinton

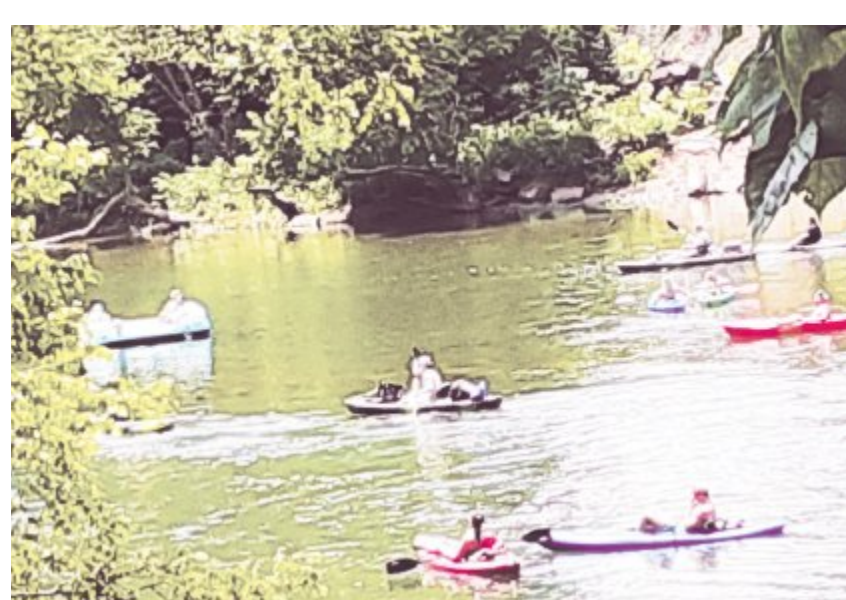

## Greenbrier River overflows with color

Few things are as peaceful and resplendent as slowly floating along the Greenbrier River. The glistening water, gorgeous fauna, passing ducks and fish swimming below make for a delightful experience. Once each year, the Greenbrier is decorated with every color of the rainbow during Second Saturday’s Color the River. Another successful event is in the books for 2022. Thousands of people from near and far came out to float the river on Saturday, June 11. Many helping hands went into making this event possible. According to Amy Richmond with the City of Hinton, multiple organi-

zations and groups were involved. Event organizers took care of registrations at the put-in located in Pence Springs. The Summers County High School Football team assisted with parking at the campground where the float began. At the take-out in Talcott, several groups helped to keep everyone safe. Talcott Volunteer Fire Department members stood by at the take-out point to help floaters out of the water and ensure everyone’s safety. The National Guard assisted firefighters. In addition to the float itself, the John Henry Museum opened early for those visiting for the event. There was coffee, t-shirts and oth-

er items for sale and plenty of displays to enjoy. Even though Color the River is a free event, many participants make donations. All of which goes toward the event and the Color the River Cancer Fund. According to the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources, approximately one in eight adults in the Mountain State (13.3 percent) are cancer survivors. The cancer fund strives to alleviate some of the financial burdens associated with a cancer diagnosis. According to Richmond, they garnered enough donations to cover the cost of the event t-shirts and still cleared over \$3000 to go

toward the cancer fund. She said those funds get divided between several families in Summers County struggling financially because of cancer. “Usually, around fall, we’ll look at how much money we have. And we’ll divvy that to six or seven different people by giving them about \$250. That helps for food and travel, that type of thing.” Of the event, Richmond said, “I think just that it was a tremendous event. Not only that we raised \$3,000 but that it brought a lot of tourists into our community and gave a fantastic family day for people from Summers County and the surrounding areas.” Richmond noted that ev-

ery year there is a modicum of concern regarding the weather and river levels. Prior to Color the River, meteorologists were calling for rain and low temperatures. Thankfully, things changed for the better. The day of the event was sunny and in the 80s. The next Second Saturdays event is scheduled for July 9. The featured band is JonBen Slate, a fan favorite. There will also be the usual vendors and food booths. For more information, visit the Second Saturdays Facebook page. Please note that there is a new page for the event. ## John Henry Days Committee honors Bill Dillon as Grand Parade Marshal

The John Henry Days Committee proudly presents John William “Bill” Dillon as the Grand Parade Marshal for their 25th Anniversary. Bill is a Talcott native who has been more than fundamental in the founding of the John Henry Days Festival. 1966 was a very busy year for Mr. Dillon, he graduated high school, married his late wife Becky, and joined the US Marine Corps serving in Vietnam from 1967 to 1968. He received a Purple Heart for wounds received in Vietnam and was honorably discharged in 1968. After discharge from the service, he received an Associate of Science Degree from Beckley College. In 1970, he began his career with the US Postal Service in Fayetteville, WV, and in 1972 was appointed Postmaster in Talcott, WV. Bill has also served on the Summers County Board of Education, Summers County Convention &

Visitors Board of Directors, Talcott-Hilldale Ruritan Club. In 2008, he was one of ten in West Virginia named to receive the Governor’s Service Award for volunteerism in his community. In 2009, he was inducted into the Mountain State University Hall of Fame and received the Alumni Community Service Award. Bill is the proud father to John (Morgan) Dillon, Danny (Pam) Dillon and Jodi Bennett and Grandfather to Clayton, Rowan, Olivia, Christian, Dani Lynn, Austin, Ashton and Abby. Over the years Bill has made numerous phone calls, trips to Charleston, and written letters to the editor to try and get funding and support for John Henry. In 1996, Bill was the advocate for the unveiling of the John Henry Stamp in Talcott. Bill did not quit until the United States Postal Service agreed to unveil the stamp in Talcott, WV rather than in Pennsyl-



vania. He’s organized hundreds of meetings, worked fundraisers, planted flowers, mowed grass and hung flags. He was the voice for John Henry at many school and civic clubs throughout West Virginia. There was not a bigger advo-

cate or cheerleader for John Henry. All of this was volunteer work, and it is a true passion for Bill. John Henry Days is celebrating 25 years this year and this festival would not be possible without volunteers like

Bill. It’s with great honor that the John Henry Days committee will celebrate him at the John Henry Park that he fought to make a reality. Please join us Sunday, June 26 at 2 p.m. to say thank you to Bill.

Currently, there are 29 vendors signed up for this year's festival. The last day to accept new vendor applications will be August 31, 2022.

Amy Richmond also discussed the music lineup for this year's festival and said Matt Mullins had booked all acts. Music will be played all four days on the downtown stage from 11:00 a.m. to 4 p.m., and on the River-town Stage from 12:00 to 4:00 p.m. Music lineup will be announced soon.

Jack Scott discussed this year's budget. Cost to be incurred will be tents for seating, seating for the City Park, a bathroom attendant, musical acts, and trolley rides. Mayor Scott requested porta johns be ordered now along with handwashing stations. A quote from A-2 Tents will also be sought prior to the next meeting.

Tina Westfall Allen reported on the Kid's Zone at the Memorial Building. Tina has verified the cost of inflatable attractions from a Lewisburg, West Virginia, vendor, as well as a trackless train. Currently, she is working on securing these attractions as well as a climbing wall. In addition, Tina plans to order stickers, whistles, and other kid-friendly giveaway items.

Tina Westfall Allen also reported the Hinton Elks have agreed to pour beverages during the four-day festival. The committee members agreed to allow the Elks to set up in the City Park where the music will be played.

Jan Plumley suggested the committee contact the Director of Nursing at Summers County ARH Hospital to inform them of the event and to invite someone to set

up and do blood pressures during Railroad Days. In addition, to contact EMS regarding the event as they will be needed in event of an emergency.

Jack Scott discussed advertisement, promotion such as a Snapchat Filter, Railroad Days stickers, and adding a QR code to the Railroad Days walking map.

Carol Jackson, a community member, and Board Member of Campbell Flanagan House Museum asked if the trolley could be stopped at the corner by their museum to allow people to exit and explore the museum. Jack Scott said he will review the routes the trolleys will take with passengers exiting and returning to the train.

Jack Scott also discussed the WV Tourism Bus and the best place for it to be set up.

Holli Lanthroum will be ordering t-shirts for committee members to wear during Hinton Railroad Days this year.

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

